

General Meeting Minutes Wednesday, May 17, 2023 7:00 pm in the LMC and via Zoom

- 1. Welcome / Call to Order
- 2. Meeting Ground Rules
 - a. We are all volunteers, and we try our best.

- 3. Principal's Report Ann Buch gave an update on the Westgate construction project. North of the Commons will be renovated this summer (including new flooring, new ceilings, new piping, lighting, etc.). There will be a new girl's bathroom on the second floor. Outside construction will start in the summer. Next summer (2024), the Commons to the South will undergo construction. There will be 11 new classrooms and a new gym twice the size of the old gym. There will be outdoor recess during the construction (locations tbd). The Variety Show will take place at Westgate on Friday, May 19th at 6:30pm. Seats are first come first serve. The 5th Grade Legacy team will run the concessions, cash only, to raise money for new recess equipment. Kindergarten screening will take place on May 23 and May 24 in the morning. If you know of any new families to Westgate who have an incoming kindergartener or first grader, please notify the office. Westgate has been allotted a 0.5 additional principal due to the enrollment numbers; the new part-time assistant principal will start next year. Field Day will be on June 2nd; rain date is June 5th. Lots of volunteers will be needed to help with Field Day!

A QR code was provided to show how happy the teachers were during this special week. Staff were blown away by the treats, food, gift cards, etc. The Westgate Countdown to Summer will begin on May 25th.
